

Overview:

Established in 2003, Riverlink is a network of land tracts and partnerships, providing this mid-coast peninsula with a wildlife corridor and trail system. The open space and greenway connect the Sheepscot and Damariscotta Rivers.

The River-Link Trail should be considered a back-country trail of moderate difficulty. Always carry water and first-aid supplies with you.

Guidelines:

- Please stay on the marked trail
- No overnight camping
- No open fires
- No motorized wheeled vehicles
- Carry in / Carry out

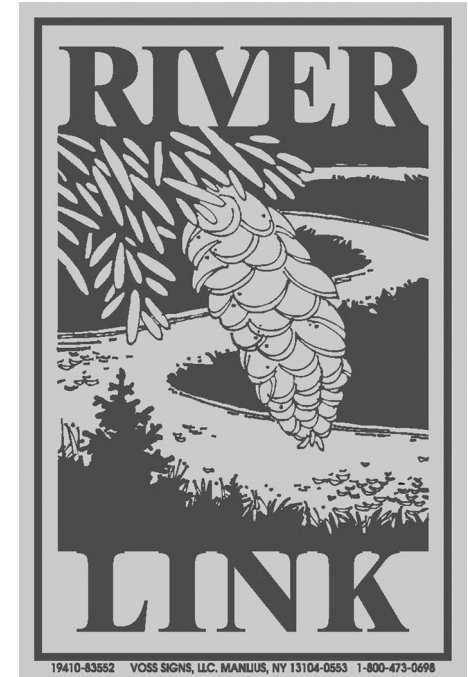

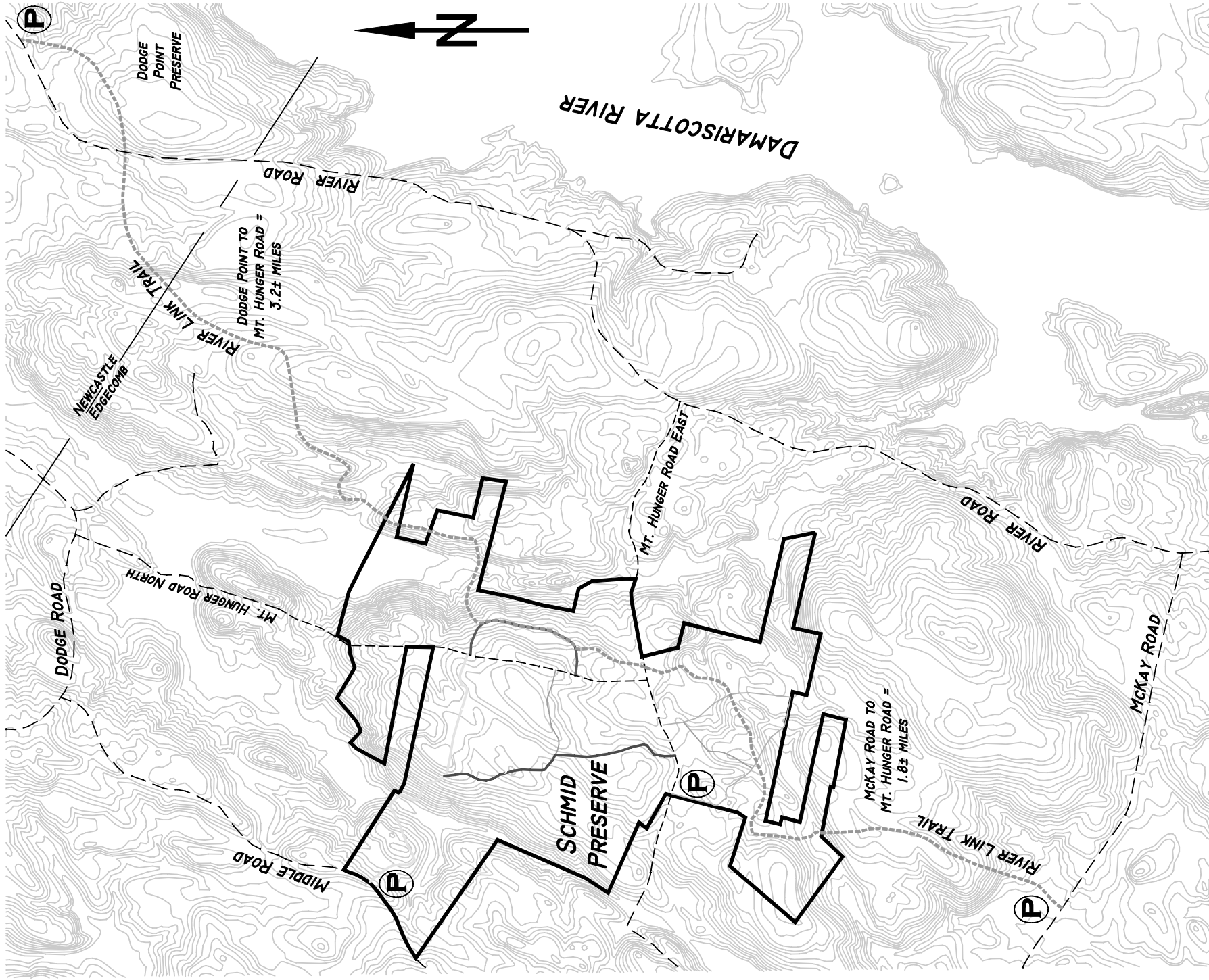
