Adopt-A-Preserve
Program

Help Boothbay Region Land Trust conserve the special places in the Boothbay region by adopting a preserve.

The Adopt-a-Preserve program offers an opportunity for the community to take an active role in caring for the special places in the region. Businesses, civic and community organizations, churches and other groups are invited to "adopt-a-preserve".

As an adopter, you would commit to the following on an annual basis:

- Recruit volunteers (your colleagues, employees, members, friends, and/or family) to participate in at least one (1) stewardship work party per year (in the fall and/or spring) on your adopted preserve. The BRLT Stewardship Coordinator and Preserve Steward would lead the work party.
- Contribute \$500 annually to the BRLT Endowment Fund to guarantee the availability of the preserves for generations to come.
- Adopt your preserve for a minimum of two years.
- If the partnership is successful for both parties, first right of refusal to adopt your preserve in subsequent years.

In appreciation for your adoption, the BRLT would commit to the following:

- Include your logo and/or name on your adopted preserve's kiosk (see attached sample).
- Feature your adoption in an article in one of the BRLT newsletters each year with a circulation of 2,500 households throughout the country.
- Include your name in at least one press release per year in the local paper.
- Invite you to the annual BRLT Picnic and Annual Meeting.
